

Recommended Supply List 2024-2025

We are asking as many students as possible to bring in Kleenex and Clorox wipes

6th & 7th grade to first hour teacher, 8th grade to second hour teacher

6th grade:

- Earbuds/headphones - These must have wires.
- PENCILS & erasers- a year's supply
- Colored pencils
- One folder for use as a "Take home" folder—should be durable
- ELA - (1) 1 subject spiral notebook, (1) 2-pocket folder, (1) pack of 3x5 index cards, (1) blank envelope with a stamp on it
- MATH – (1) 1" binder (1) pack of dry erase markers to be used as a class
- SCIENCE - **all materials to be kept in class**
(2) one-subject notebooks (2) 2-pocket folders, (2) glue sticks, (1) one highlighter, (1) one pen
- SOCIAL STUDIES - (1) one-subject spiral notebook that will be kept in the classroom
- Optional for all classes: wireless mouse, pencil bag
- *We don't recommend Trapper Keeper type binders*

7th grade:

- 4 different colored folder/binder
- A year's supply of pens, pencils, erasers, a highlighter
- Pencil case/zipper bag
- Lined paper
- Headphones
- MATH: 2" 3-ring binder with pockets, spiral notebook, dry erase markers, and glue sticks.
- SCIENCE: (1) folder, pencil sharpener, (2) glue sticks and (2) spiral notebooks (turn in to Mrs. Magos first week of school),
- SOCIAL STUDIES: 2 pocket folders, colored pencils, multi-colored highlighters, fine point black Sharpie, and headphones.
- ELA: (2) writing notebooks, folder, 1-inch binder, colored pencils, markers, glue stick, scissors, 1-2 black Sharpies, wired headphones, LOTS OF PENCILS

8th grade:

- Pens/pencils/erasers - year supply
- Corded headphones
- MATH: 1 ½ or 2" 3-ring binder with pockets and clear cover. Package of dry erase markers to keep in class AND package of skinny dry erase markers. Two pocket folder and spiral notebook.
A donation of 4 AAA batteries for graphing calculators is greatly appreciated.
- AMERICAN HISTORY: Composition notebook, corded headphones, coloring utensils
- SCIENCE: 2 ~ Spiral Notebooks, 2 pocket folder, 2 glue sticks to stay in school
- ELA: 2-pocket folder, writing utensils
- SPANISH: Notebook, Folder (2-pocket or binder style)

For PE Students

- All Students - Standards of Excellence Book #1 (red)
- Clarinet, Saxophone players - 3 to 5 reeds to begin the year with (I would recommend Vandoren 2.5 reeds)
- Trumpet, Baritone - Valve Oil
- Trombone Slide - Grease
- Percussion - Snare Sticks (preferably Vic Firth SD1 General), Medium Hard Yarn wound mallets (preferably Mike Balter Brand), Hard plastic tip xylophone/bell mallets. A stick bag is not required but is very helpful to keep everything together and safe.
- Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, and Trombone players need their own instrument

7th and 8th Band -

- All Students - Standards of Excellence Book #1 (red, we will use it for review)
- Clarinet, Saxophone players - 3 to 5 reeds I would recommend Vandoren 3 reeds
- Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone, Tuba - Valve Oil and slide grease
- Trombone Slide - Grease
- Percussion - Snare Sticks (preferably Vic Firth 5A), Medium Hard Yarn wound mallets (preferably Mike Balter Brand), Hard plastic tip xylophone/bell mallets. A stick bag is not required but is very helpful to keep everything together and safe.
- Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, and Trombone players need their own instrument
